Golf Programs Australia Inc. A Little History...

The idea for a Purpose Built Golf Facility was first developed by PGA Professional Darrell Dalton in 2015.

The Special Olympics Australia Golf Program was established at Tanawha Valley Golf & Tennis Centre on the Sunshine Coast in 2014.

Darrell believed golf would be a perfect vehicle to offer more than just the activity of golf to his program participants.

In 2015 GPAI was registered as a charity organisation with the goal of using the activity of golf to drive inclusion & break isolation for underprivileged groups in the community.

In December 2016 GPAI opened its charity store at 89 Currie Street, Nambour & began providing social enterprise training for intellectually disabled golf program participants.

Trainees are mentored in retail, business & creativity by store mentor Michelle Dalton & team, which develops into targeted social enterprise business training over time.

As a bespoke mentor Michelle soon matches a student's passion with a concept & works with them to establish a deliverable social enterprise business outcome.

GPAI currently provides social enterprise training for 6 of its golf program participants.

The organisational vision is to establish a Purpose Built Golf Facility (PBGF) in every state & territory in Australia.

In Australia there are approximately 600,000 individuals living with an intellectual disability.
